

ORDINANCE NO. 14-93BY: John M. Brennan


An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and the Auditor to execute an agreement with Sticklen-Belsheim & Associates for general traffic engineering services related to traffic regulations, control and design, and to declare an emergency.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:


Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, with Sticklen-Belsheim & Associates, to be effective upon passage of this Ordinance, providing for general traffic engineering services related to traffic regulations, control and design.

Section 2. That the amount of \$10,000.00 has been appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund to Account Number 03-380-119 in the 1993 Appropriations Ordinance to be used to provide general traffic engineering services pursuant to said agreement, and that the agreement shall not exceed this amount.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to utilize these services as traffic problems arise, and that this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

Dear Mayor Madison:

We propose to render General Traffic Engineering Services related to traffic regulations, control and design for the City of Bexley. You are expected to furnish us with full information as to your requirements including any special or extraordinary considerations for work you request or special services needed, and also to make available all pertinent existing data.

Our Basic Services will consist of preparing studies and reports, preparing or assisting in preparing programming forms and documents, preparing design documents, performing traffic engineering design, and attending meetings. We will also furnish such Additional Services as you may request.

You hereby agree to pay a fee for services performed, inclusive of our direct payroll cost plus a cost for office overhead, computer time, transportation, general office operations, and profit for our services, in accordance with the following hourly rates:

Principal.....	\$77.58
Engineer.....	59.02
CADD Operator.....	34.80
Technician.....	27.43
Draftsperson.....	27.43

Reimbursable Expenses incurred in conjunction with all Basic and Additional Services will be charged on the basis of actual costs.

We will bill you monthly for services and Reimbursable Expenses. The above financial arrangements are on the basis of prompt payment of our bills and the orderly and continuous progress on the work requested.



Our services will be available upon your acceptance of the proposal. We would expect to start any specific assignment promptly after receipt of a request from you and propose to complete our services in the time established for each assignment requested.

It is necessary that you advise us in writing at an early date if you have budgetary limitations for services requested. We must accept any such limitations as being realistic and we will then endeavor to work within those limitations. If you request, we will submit to you periodically our opinions as to the probability of completing assignments within your budget and, where appropriate, request an adjustment in the budget or a revision in the extent or quality of the assignment.

The amount of work authorized under this proposal is \$8,900.00.

This proposal represents the entire understanding between the City of Bexley and Sticklen Belsheim & Associates with respect to General Traffic Engineering Services and may only be modified in writing signed by both of us. If it satisfactorily sets forth your understanding of our agreement, we would appreciate your signing the enclosed copy of this letter in the space provided below and returning it to us.


