

ORDINANCE NO. 61 -94By: Richard F. Weber

An Ordinance to approve a collective bargaining agreement by and between the City of Bexley and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 8, AFL-CIO, with respect to employees in the City of Bexley Service Department for the term beginning January 1, 1995 and ending on December 31, 1997, to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute said agreement and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the collective bargaining agreement by and between the City of Bexley and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 8, AFL-CIO, with respect to employees in the City of Bexley Service Department for the term beginning January 1, 1995 and ending December 31, 1997 is hereby approved in the form submitted to this Council and attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement by and on behalf of the City of Bexley.



That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to assure that the collective bargaining agreement is in effect as of January 1, 1995, and shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
