

ORDINANCE NO. 49 -95

An Ordinance to transfer \$15,000 from the unencumbered General Fund to the Recreation Fund, to appropriate \$15,000 from the Recreation Fund to the Professional Services Account #05-520-171 for the purpose of paying class instructors, and to appropriate \$2,000 from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paying for emergency repairs to the heating and air conditioning system at Jeffrey Mansion.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$15,000 is hereby transferred from the unencumbered General Fund to the Recreation Fund.

Section 2. That \$15,000 is hereby appropriated from the Recreation Fund to the Professional Services Account #05-520-171 for the purpose of paying class instructors for the balance of 1995.

Section 3. That \$2,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of paying for emergency repairs to the heating and air conditioning system at Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
