

ORDINANCE NO. 32 -96By: Jeffrey L. McClelland


An Ordinance to appropriate \$2,000 from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the costs of screening and qualifying candidates for appointment as uniformed police officers in the Bexley Police Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$2,000 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the costs of screening and qualifying candidates for appointment as uniformed officers in the Bexley Police Department.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
