

ORDINANCE NO. 84 -96By: Jeffrey L. McClelland

An Ordinance to authorize the Auditor to accept gifts and donations for the purpose of paying costs associated with the development of a promotional video for the City, to appropriate for such purpose an amount equal to the aggregate contributions so received and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor is authorized and directed to receive donations from the public to pay costs incurred by the City in connection with the development of a Bexley promotional video.

Section 2. That an amount equal to the contributions received for such purpose is hereby appropriated to pay the costs of such video, it being the intention of this Council that, unless otherwise expressly appropriated by a separate ordinance adopted by Council, the City shall only be obligated to pay the costs associated with the video if, and to the extent that, the City receives contributions for such purpose.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of paying promptly costs associated with the development of the promotional as contributions are received, and shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


