

ORDINANCE NO. 25 -97By: Jeffrey L. McClelland

An Ordinance to declare a real and present emergency in connection with the operation of Jeffrey Park, to appropriate \$18,300.00 from the Capital Improvements Fund to pay for converting the current driveway exit onto Clifford Avenue into a two-way driveway, to authorize a contract between the City and Chemcote Inc. for such work without formal bidding and advertising, pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the current driveway at the north end of Jeffrey Mansion and the traffic thereon create a risk of injury to persons using the Park, particularly small children coming from and going to the play area at the north end of the Meadow; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that such risks can be eliminated or substantially reduced by closing a portion of the north driveway; and

WHEREAS, the closing of a portion of the north driveway eliminates vehicle access to the Meadow area, and a new vehicular entrance to the Meadow is required,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the risk of injury posed by a portion of the north driveway at Jeffrey Park is hereby declared a real and present emergency within the meaning of Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2. That \$18,300.00 hereby is appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund to pay for the cost of furnishing materials and labor for the conversion of the exit driveway into a vehicle entrance and exit.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a contract on behalf of the City with Chemcote Inc. for labor and materials in connection with the conversion of the exit driveway to Clifton Avenue into an entrance and exit without formal bidding and advertisement pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, as set forth in Section 1 hereof, and this Ordinance shall be into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
