

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 27-97

An Ordinance to appropriate \$101,155.00 from the Capital Improvements Fund for capital improvements.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$101,155.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund for the purchase of the following:

a) Computer upgrades for Service Department, Building Department, Recreation Department & Police Department	\$ 14,167.00
b) Crack sealing material	\$ 10,000.00 ✓
c) Traffic line striper	\$ 5,800.00 ✓
d) Front mower riding tractor	\$ 16,200.00 ✓
e) Gas detector	\$ 2,600.00 ✓
f) Reprogramming Police Dept. radios to unshared frequency	\$ 1,575.00
g) Portable radios and accessories	\$ 15,000.00 ✓
h) Emergency generator for Police building	\$ 13,633.00 ✓
i) Skag mower	\$ 3,300.00 ✓
j) Echo hedge trimmer	\$ 380.00 ✓
k) Outdoor light fixtures	\$ 1,500.00
l) Repair slate gazebo roof	\$ 3,700.00
m) Typewriter	\$ 800.00
n) Computer upgrades for Auditor's Office	<u>\$ 12,500.00</u>
	<b>\$101,155.00</b>

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of goods and services as specified above.

Section 3. That the contracts authorized herein, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.


Section 4. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
