

SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 21-99

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 7-99 which established rates of pay for all salaried employees, Police Chief, Police Captain, Health Commissioner, Sanitarian, and Part-Time, Temporary and Casual employees of the City of Bexley, effective as of January 1, 1999, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Schedule I is hereby amended by changing the effective date of the 1999 annual salary of the Assistant Finance Director from February 1, 1999 to January 23, 1999.

Section 2. That Schedule I is hereby amended by deleting from such schedule the annual salary of \$40,456 for the Ground Maintenance Supervisor effective April 8, 1999, and adding the annual salary of \$50,000 for the Information Systems Manager effective March 9, 1999.

Section 3. That Schedule I is hereby amended by adding the following:

Effective February 22, 1999, the Administrative Assistant to the Mayor will be paid on the anniversary date of hire to the position an annual salary based on the stated years of continuous employment in the position as follows:

Starting rate	\$27,500
After 1st year	\$29,800
After 2nd year	\$32,500
After 3rd year	\$35,000

Section 4. That Section I is hereby amended by adding the following:

The Secretary to the Service Department will be paid \$14.43 per hour through March 24, 1999, after which such position shall terminate.

Section 5: That Section 3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3: That all amounts listed above for Schedule I Employees are the annual salaries for such employees. For purposes of payroll convenience, bi-weekly paychecks will be processed with a payroll amount based upon an hourly rate. Such hourly rate will be determined by dividing the employee's annual salary by 2,080 hours, and the payroll amount will be determined by dividing the employee's annual salary by the number of pay periods in the year. Except for scheduled pay steps, all pay increases shall be effective as of January 1 and shall

be calculated, for the year in which pay steps are completed, by pro-rating the increase based upon the employee's anniversary date.

Section 6. That, as modified by this Ordinance, Ordinance No. 7-99 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. That in order to assure uninterrupted City services, this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall be effective as of January 1, 1999, upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
