

RESOLUTION NO. 10 -00By: Jeff McClelland

A Resolution authorizing the Police Department to hire two police applicants in order to have them enrolled in the Police Academy Class scheduled to begin on November 6, 2000, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Council has previously established the approved staffing level of the Police Department at 28 sworn officers;

and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is anticipating two vacancies due to retirement or resignation, and the next Police Academy Class will not convene until March 2001, and this Council has determined that it is in the public interest to maintain the Police Department at 28 sworn officers ;
NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That, in order to avoid working with staff shortages for an extended period of time, the Police Department is hereby authorized to hire two personnel, in excess of the approved staffing level of 28 sworn personnel. This approval is for the specific purpose of placing these two applicants in the Police Academy Class that is scheduled to begin on November 6, 2000, and does not alter the previously approved staffing level of 28 sworn personnel.

Section 2. That this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to maintain the Department at its authorized staffing level at the earliest possible date, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


