

ORDINANCE 69 - 00By: Jed Morison

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance 59-99 to appropriate \$3,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying the firm of Schottenstein, Zox and Dunn, special counsel to the City, for matters relating to development of a right-of-way policy, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 59-99 appropriated \$3,000.00 for the purpose of hiring the firm of Reminger and Reminger as special counsel for right-of-way-matters; and

WHEREAS, the City's participation with other cities in formulating specific right-of-way policies makes it necessary to hire the firm of Schottenstein, Zox and Dunn to perform these duties rather than Reminger & Reminger. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance 59-99 is amended so that the amount of \$3,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying Schottenstein, Zox and Dunn, special counsel to the City.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, the emergency being the need to complete the City's right-of-way policy as soon as possible, and shall go into force and effect upon its signing by the Mayor.


