

ORDINANCE NO. 91-00By: Jed W. Morison

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and the Auditor to enter into labor agreements negotiated pursuant to Chapter 4117, Ohio Revised Code, between the City and the Fraternal Order of Police, Capital City Lodge No. 9, and Ohio Council 8, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City has negotiated labor agreements with the labor organizations listed above;

WHEREAS, the bargaining unit members represented by the labor organizations listed above have previously ratified such labor agreements; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration has recommended approval of such labor agreements by this Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the labor agreements recommended by the administration and presented to this Council be, and the same hereby are, ratified and approved, and that the Mayor and the Auditor are authorized and directed to execute said agreements on behalf of the City, subject to any revisions as shall be approved by legal counsel.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare to assure uninterrupted service and to provide benefits at the earliest time possible, and accordingly, shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, without more than one reading in regard to its passage.
