

ORDINANCE NO. 7 - 02

An Ordinance to appropriate \$4,344.90 from the unencumbered General Fund for payment, subject to receipt of evidence of full satisfaction, of a claim for medical services rendered to a dependent of an employee for which insurance coverage was denied by the City's health insurer after previously covering such services.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$4,344.90 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the payment, subject to receipt of evidence of full satisfaction, of a claim for medical services rendered to a dependent of an employee for which insurance coverage was denied by the City's health insurer after previously covering such services.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
