

ORDINANCE NO. 20-02

An Ordinance to appropriate an additional \$20,000.00 to pay for professional consulting and inspections related to building services and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, the amount of professional consulting and inspection services needed is directly related to the amount of construction occurring in the City, and

Whereas, exceptionally large projects have begun and/or are scheduled to begin during this construction season, and

Whereas, the amount of funds budgeted for the year 2002 did not take into account those large projects, and

Whereas, the dollars spent on professional consulting and inspection services are reimbursed to the City in the form of permit fees, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY OHIO,

Section 1. That the amount of \$20,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to account number 0135051190 for the purpose of paying for professional consulting and inspection services.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and health, said emergency being the need to provide these services on an ongoing basis, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
