

ORDINANCE NO. 28 -2

An Ordinance to appropriate \$37,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for the installation of a roof on the Municipal Garage; to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract; and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, the roof on the Municipal Garage was damaged by a wind storm, and

Whereas, the City's insurer has provided funding to the City for the replacement of the roof. Now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That the amount of \$37,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for the installation of a roof on the Municipal Garage.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor should be and hereby are authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement by law.


Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of public safety and health, the emergency being the need to replace of the damaged roof, and shall take effect and be in force upon its signing by the Mayor.
