

ORDINANCE NO. 41-03

An ordinance to appropriate an additional \$946.22 from the unencumbered Capital Improvement Fund, for the purpose of paying EMH&T for professional consulting, inspection, and engineering services associated with the collapse of the southwest retaining wall at Jeffrey Park and to declare an emergency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That \$946.22 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvement Fund for the purpose of paying for costs associated to the professional consulting, inspection, and engineering services, at Jeffrey Park, in relation to the collapse of the southwest retaining wall.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity to adequately pay for services already completed, and continue to maintain a schedule to complete construction prior to the 2003 season, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
