

ORDINANCE NO. 88 -04

An Ordinance to extend Chapter 1223 of the Planning Code until the earlier of the effective date of Ordinance No. 81-04 or December 31, 2004 and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Chapter 1223 expired on September 30, 2004, and Ordinance No. 81-04 which would extend Chapter 1223 indefinitely was introduced on October 26, 2004, and is presently pending; and


WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to continue the protections of Chapter 1223 in effect until this Council has had an opportunity to conduct a orderly public process, including a public hearing, regarding the extension of Chapter 1223;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Chapter 1223 of the Planning Code as in effect prior to October 1, 2004, is hereby extended until the earlier of the effective date of Ordinance No. 81-04 or December 31, 2004.


Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection of the public health, safety or welfare, said emergency being the necessity of continuing to protect and preserve property values as contemplated by Section 1223.01 while Ordinance No. 81-04 is pending before this Council, and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
