An Ordinance to establish the positions of one part time Code Enforcement Officer/Fire Safety Inspector and one part time Code Enforcement Officer and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the full time position of Assistant Code Enforcement Officer is vacant; and,

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that it is in the public interest to fill the position. NOW, THEREFORE,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO**


Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to replace the position of one full time Assistant Code Enforcement Officer with two (part time) employee's as indicated in the following sections 2 and 3.

Section 2. That the first position of (part time) Code Enforcement/Fire Safety Inspector is established with the job responsibilities and qualifications as provided for in the attached job description at \$18.00 per hr. ~~annual salary of \$25,170.00~~.

Section 3. That the second position of (part time) Code Enforcement Officer is established with the job responsibilities and qualifications as provided for in the attached job description at \$15.00 per hr. ~~annual salary of \$21,528.00~~.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and the preservation of property values within the community. The emergency being the need to fill positions as soon as possible, and shall take effect upon it's signing by the Mayor.


