

ORDINANCE NO. 56 - 07

An Ordinance to amend Sections 290.01 and 290.03 of the Administrative Code extending the term of the Jeffrey Mansion Commission to September 30, 2007 and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 209.01(b) and (c) of the Administrative Code is hereby amended as follows:

(b) Voting members shall serve a term commencing with the effective date of their appointment and ending on September 30, 2007 unless extended by ordinance of Council.

(c) The Commission shall expire on September 30, 2007 unless extended by ordinance of Council.

Section 2. That Section 209.01(a) of the Administrative Code is hereby amended as follows:

(a) The Commission shall:

(1) Prepare a definitive programmatic, operational and financial plan (the "Plan") for restoration and expansion of Jeffrey Mansion, including, and as the Commission deems necessary or appropriate, the grounds comprising Jeffrey Park, as a multi-purpose community center for recreational, educational and social uses as contemplated by the Bexley Heritage Fund Report presented at the October 10, 2006 regular meeting of Council.

(2) Prepare and submit to Council for its prior approval a budget, reflecting a combination of public and private funding, for development of the Plan and inclusion in appropriations for the calendar year 2007.

(3) Solicit and receive gifts and contribution in the name of the City to fund the Commission and the Plan.

(4) Select and retain one or more consultants, in accordance with applicable law, to assist the Commission in developing the Plan.

(5) Submit the Plan to Council on or before September 30, 2007 unless extended by ordinance of Council.

Section 3. That as amended by Sections 1 and 2 above, Chapter 290 shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety or welfare, said emergency being the necessity of extending the term of the Commission, which is presently set to expire on June 30,

2007, so that the Commission may compete its work, and shall be effective upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
