

ORDINANCE 58 - 12

An Ordinance to establish the salary for the office of Bexley Mayor for the year 2014 and beyond

WHEREAS, the annual salary for the Mayor of Bexley was last established by Bexley City Council at \$101,000; and

WHEREAS, the Bexley City Charter calls for any changes to the salaries of elected officials to be passed, by ordinance, at least one year prior to the commencement of the new term for the elected position;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

Section 1.

The Mayor's annual salary shall be \$101,000 for the year 2014 plus the annual rate of change as is received as standard by non-bargaining unit employees in 2014, if any. The Mayor's annual salary shall change at the same annual rate of change as is received as standard by non-bargaining unit employees for every year thereafter.

Section 2.

The Mayor's annual vehicle allowance shall remain at \$5,500 for the year 2014, and shall change for the year 2015, and every year thereafter, based upon the rate of change between the IRS standard mileage rate in the new year over the IRS standard mileage rate from the year prior.

Section 3.

This ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
