

ORDINANCE NO. 19 - 19

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$37,000 FROM THE RECREATION FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING FOR TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE EXPENSES.

Whereas, The Recreation and Parks Department has operated the Bexley Before and After Care Program at the Bexley School facilitates since 2016; and

Whereas, students from Cassingham are transported via bus by the Bexley Recreation and Parks Department to the after school location at Montrose; and

Whereas, over the past couple of years the number of Cassingham students registered for after school that need to be transported to Montrose has grown significantly requiring two bus trips with the Recreation and Parks Department's current 27 passenger bus; and

Whereas, Cassingham student registration for the 2019/20 Before and After Care Program is so high that we have had to put upwards of 20 students on the waitlist as we do not currently have the transportation capacity; and

Whereas, additional bus capacity would allow us to better service Bexley residents that rely on the after school program for day care services; and

Whereas, the payback period on the additional bus purchase is estimated to be two years;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1. That \$37,000 is hereby appropriated from the Recreation Fund for the purpose of paying for transportation vehicle expenses.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
