**NARRATIVE FOR PATROL OFFICER EDWARD P GLICK**

On 10/26/20 at 0348 hours a traffic stop was attempted on a 2002-2006 black Acura MDX for marked lanes and displaying the tag of another vehicle. The operator failed to comply and ran a stop sign and red flashing traffic light onto a four lane road at speeds in excess of 80 MPH in a 35 MPH. The pursuit was terminated with no crashes and no apprehensions after one minute and 16 seconds covering 1.3 miles.
