STATUS: Stole VIN: ON JUNE 15, 2021 AT ABOUT 11:20PM, AT BROAD AND DREXEL, POLICE OBSERVED A SILVER PRIUS THROW AND HIT THE CAR NEXT TO THEM WITH A WATER BOTTLE. POLICE ATTEMPTED TO STOP THE PRIUS. THE PRIUS REFUSED TO STOP. POLICE FOLLOWED THE VEHICLE FOR A SHORT TIME BEFORE CALLING THE PURSUIT OFF. SEVERAL MINUTES LATER, THE PRUIS WAS FOUND ABANDONED IN THE MIDDLE OF LIVINGSTON AVE BY MOO MOOS. A WITNESS ADVISED THE CAR WAS SMOKING AND 4 M/B JUVENILES RAN FROM THE CAR. THE PRUIS PLATES DID NOT MATCH THE VIN ON THE PRIUS. THE PRIUS WAS REPORTED STOLEN FROM CPD. THE PLATES WERE TAKEN BUT NOT REPORTED STOLEN; THE OWNER WILL PICK UP THE PLATE IN MORNING.

THE PRIUS HAD A BULLET HOLE IN THE DRIVERS SIDE OPERA WINDOW. CPD WAS CONTACTED. CPD SGT 9 ARRIVED AND ADVISED CPD DID NOT WANT THE CAR FOR ANY REASON. THE PRIUS WAS RELEASED TO THE OWNER ON SCENE.
