Sometime between Saturday, 9/10/22 at 1200 and 9/21/22 and unknown hours, unknown person(s) did, with the purpose to deprive the owner of property obtain control over mailed checks from unknown locations (either from Bexley, Columbus, or Whitehall), in violation of Section 2913,02 A-1 of the ORC, a misdemeanor of the 1st degree.

On Wednesday, 9/21/22 at an unknown hour, unknown person(s) did, knowing he was facilitating a fraud, forge a writing, check to the order of "John Doe" drawn on the Huntington Bank, signed in the name of the "holder", so that the said check was purported to be genuine when in fact spurious, and the check was not actually paid to the order of "John Doe", in violation of Section 2913.31 A-1 of the ORC, a felony of the 5th degree.
